

Sh. R. S. BAJWA ISA National Award for Best Papers on Total Intravenous Anaesthesia

Criteria & Details of the Award:

This award has been started in the loving memory of Late Sh. Randhir Singh Bajwa, father of Dr. Sukhminder Bajwa. This award is for the three best papers on TIVA (Total Intravenous Anaesthesia). The research manuscript should have been published or accepted for publication in any PubMed journal (preferably IJA). All applications should reach the office of Hon. Secretary ISA NHQ before 30th September. The best papers will be evaluated by a jury of Vice President, Editor, Hon. Secretary and any one GC member who has accomplished good work in the field of TIVA/Research & Publications. The award will be given during the IJA/ISA Session at the ISA Annual National Conference of the award year. The other criteria and details are as follow:

- 1. Age should be less than 50 years.**
- 2. Original Research Article must have been published/accepted for publication in IJA/any PubMed indexed Journal from 1st July of the previous year to 30th June of the Award year.**
- 3. Applicant should be the first, second or corresponding author only. If all the three apply then the preference will be given in the following order; first, second and corresponding author.**
- 4. The research paper should not have won any award earlier at any ISA Conference or CME.**
- 5. Author should be an active ISA member (membership date should be**

earlier than submission date of the article to IJA/other Journal)

- 6. The Applicant should also be a member of ISA FBF before sending the application to ISA.**
- 7. First and Second prize of Rs 15000/10000 will be given for the first two ranked papers along with a medal and a certificate.**
- 8. All the other applicants will be given the consolation prizes and certificates.**
- 9. Winners of the award will be given an invitation as an author in the PG issue of IJA as well as enrolled into reviewer board of IJA and PEAK journal.**
